- 10 Mint leaves
- 1 Soda water

Procedure:

Fresh mint and sugar to be muddled. Add passion fruit and squeeze in limes. Add crushed ice, top up with rum and soda.

Feet up, close your eyes and picture yourself on the beach, feet in the sand, the glow of the sunset on your face and your favourite person by your side.
