## Kurumba Maldives Staff And Volunteers Rescue Corals & Create Largest Coral Frame In The Maldives

A team of volunteers joined forces with Kurumba staff on 17th December to rescue corals from a land reclamation project and help create the largest coral frames in the Maldives. Thanks to the efforts of the team, two massive 20ft coral frames packed with transplated coral have been created on the house reef at Kurumba. The two adjacent frames are the largest of their kind in the Maldives and together to form a new 40ft-long coral garden.

The group of Kurumba staff, Maldivians, expats and local NGO Save the Beach Maldives, spent the day searching underwater for live coral colonies in a section of water designated for land reclamation.

It is hoped that the recently transplated coral will adapt well to its new environment and eventually completely engulf the metal frames stretching 40ft across the sea bed, a few meters off the shore at Kurumba Maldives. We hope that you will visit the coral frame on your next visit to Kurumba!

## Raising The Bar

As I am sure you have already seen, we are actively revitalizing the island with resort upgrades, creating a unique and vibrant guest experience.

Over the past months, we have completed the final works in Thila, changed the bathroom location at Kandu (the main bar) to allow for upgraded bathrooms, better ocean views from the Café and Vihamana, and to allow these outlets as well as Thila to all have views of the live entertainment at night times.

In terms of room developments, DVD players have been added to the Superior and Deluxe Rooms, along with make-up mirrors, high quality hair dryers to all guests rooms and emergency lights.

New loungers for Athiri (previously the Sand Bar) have been ordered and will offer a great option to the turquoise bean bags.

The Colours of Kurumba newsletter will be changed to a 7-day version in order to reduce paper and printing. This consolidation will also make easier reading for guests.

By popular demand, we have now included sea kayaks and stand-up paddleboards for guests, which has had a very positive feedback

In the year ahead, we are intending to upgrade Vihamana restaurant to make a much easier flow for the buffet, setting up a much lighter color scheme, sound absorbing materials and sky lights for more natural light. We will be adding two-espresso coffee stations which will make getting your coffee faster.

The next item will be some refreshment works for the area surrounding the pool, which will improve the aesthetics in the area.
